

# Camp Massapoag

Camp Massapoag campers enjoy theme based, enriching experiences, leadership opportunities, group games, choice activities, and so much more! Campers are disconnected from electronics, and experience fun and adventure completely outdoors on our beautiful 38 acres.

#### Scampers | Age 5 (Rising Kindergartners)

Rising Kindergartners are placed in our co-ed Scamper group. This group is limited to 20 campers to provide smaller staff to camper ratios. Scampers must be age 5 by their 1st day of camp to be eligible to attend.

Member: \$310/week
Non-member: \$430/week

#### Peewee, Pathfinder, & Poagtown | Ages 6-11

Campers ages 6-11 are placed by birthday into 16 different co-ed groups. They participate in activities each day such as swimming, archery, arts & crafts, ropes, and boating. Groups in Pathfinder and older will have the opportunity to do 2-3 choice activites a day.

Member: \$290/week
Non-member: \$410/week

#### Pioneers | Ages 12-14

Campers ages 12-14 are placed in our Pioneer group. They have programming that respects their ages and challenges them to be role models for younger campers. Pioneers are given the opportunity to be leaders among their peers. They are also given additional privileges at camp; such as the Pio Overnight.

Member: \$290/week
Non-member: \$410/week

### LIT (Leader in Training) | Age 15

Our Leader-in-Training program includes leadership development, hands-on experience, and an overnight adventure experience for campers age 15. LITs learn vital leadership skills as a role model for younger campers. Each day they will have small-group instruction on leadership and community engagement in addition to the Camp Massopoag activities they know and love. LITs must be 15 by the first day of their session and submit an LIT application in order to register.

Member: \$870/4 week program
Non-Member: \$1,230/4 week program
